Financial Update for First Quarter

For the first quarter, HPC income was \$37,929. This is considerably more than the budgeted amount, primarily because some people chose to pay their entire pledge at one time. Total expenses for the quarter were \$25,753, slightly less than budgeted. Expenses are expected to increase later in the year as expenses for the search for a new pastor are incurred and perhaps a new pastor is named.
